## WINE, DINE, BEER TASTINGS & MORE ON STEAMRAIL'S OTWAY EXPLORER



Departing from Southern Cross station – explore the Otway’s aboard Steamrail vintage train behind 2 classic 1950s T Class diesels.

Sit back in comfortable 1920s and 1940s vintage compartment carriages, relax over coffee in the Club Cars or travel in the former mail sorting carriage enjoying the fresh air as the train roars across the flat volcanic plains and through historic towns to Colac and Camperdown.

Enjoy the wines and beers of the Otway region, travel into the Otway ranges and walk in the tree tops at the Otway Fly or explore Colac or Camperdown.

After a full day of exploring, relax with a light snack and refreshments from the kiosk or dance your way home in the dance car.

### WINE AND BEER EXPERIENCE

- Talk to the brewer, tour the brewery and sample some of the 18 varieties of hand crafted beers and ciders over a 2 course lunch at the Otway Estate brewery.
- Sample the wines of the region and relax to jazz at the Gosling Creek Winery.
- Rejoin the train at the beautiful Birragurra station with its orchard of plum trees.

### OTWAY TREE TOP WALK

- Travel through the Otway ranges catching glimpse of the former Beech Forest narrow gauge railway to the Otway Tree Top Walk.
- Optional 2 course lunch at the Otway fly.
- Walk through the tree tops 30 metre above the ground at the Otway Tree Top Walk.
- Explore the rain forest on the interactive trail – perfect for the budding young rangers.

### COLAC

Explore historic Colac, relax over lunch at one of the hotels or fine cafes. Walk to the lake or wander the town admiring the architecture of the buildings and churches.

### CAMPERDOWN

Stay aboard the train as it travels on to Camperdown to reverse. Camperdown has much history and many fine cafes and hotels. Stroll the 2km long beautiful elm lined main street. Relax and enjoy a quiet afternoon in one of the many fine cafes or hotels.

Go first class! Enjoy exclusive use of Club Car Moorabool, morning tea, wine and cheese and a light supper on the journey back to Melbourne.

### ON TRAIN SERVICES
